The overall winner of *Designs of the Year* is chosen by a prestigious jury panel, and the winner is presented at a gala awards reception.

What will the role involve?

The role involves assisting the Exhibitions team with the preparation and delivery of this exciting exhibition and would suit someone hoping to gain experience in exhibition project management and /or curating. <u>Tasks include:</u>

- · Working with the exhibition curator to research the nominated projects
- Developing several detailed *Excel* spreadsheets, e.g. list of nominators, summary of each nominated design etc
- Assisting with correspondence to the nominators and nominees to develop the content of the exhibition
- Creating presentations of each design project on PowerPoint

This is a fixed term placement for two volunteers for 3 months, working two days a week, starting mid-March 2018.
