

CURATORIAL RESEARCH ASSISTANT

VOLUNTEER PLACEMENT

Through its permanent and temporary exhibitions, the Design Museum displays contemporary design across a range of disciplines – architecture, transport, fashion, graphic and product design.

Recently re-located to Kensington High Street, the museum's mission is to help people understand the value of design.

What will the role involve?

The Curatorial Research Assistant will support the Curators in the early development of a forthcoming temporary exhibition exploring the future of the home and the changing aspects of contemporary domestic life. This exhibition will open in November 2018.

Tasks may include:

- Working closely with the curatorial team on the development and conceptualisation of the exhibition
- Researching material, e.g. literature, other exhibitions, historical objects closely related to the chosen theme of the exhibition
- Reporting research findings to the Senior Curator
- · Compiling and maintaining a clear record of findings
- Spending some days working in libraries around London

The placement

This is a fixed-term placement volunteering 2-3 days a week for three months starting towards the end of February 2018.

Skills and experience

The museum is looking for someone with:

- · An interest in curating and delivering exhibitions
- Good understanding and knowledge of contemporary design, including architecture
- · Good research and editing skills
- Excellent communication skills, both verbal and oral
- Competence using Microsoft Word, Excel and Outlook

- A good knowledge of contemporary design practices and debates
