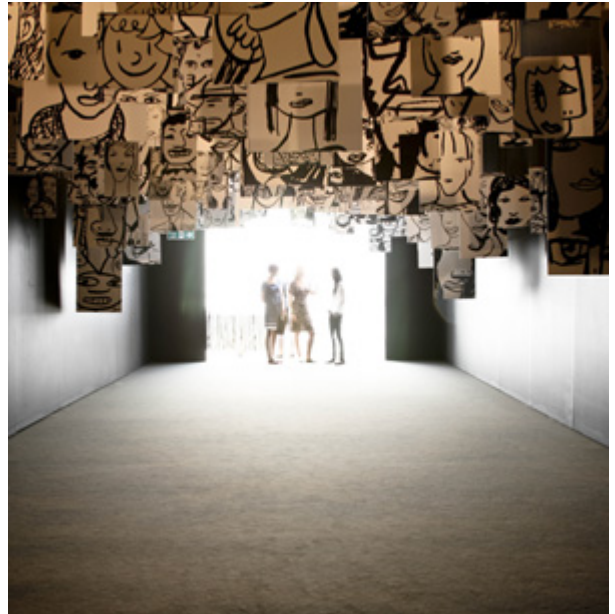

By creating and controlling animation film footage in real time, Mariscal has devised his 'Conference' which is the spontaneous and instantaneous application of his creative thinking onto the silver screen. In this energetic live performance Mariscal manifests the images, voices, narrative and content that transport his characters, the Garriris, from the universe of his imagination onto the screen. Javier Mariscal is probably best known for the creation of Cobi, the adaptable and versatile mascot for the 1992 Barcelona Olympics, as well as iconic designs for company identities, interiors and products. His retrospective at the Design Museum 'Mariscal Drawing Life' runs until 1st November.
