

## Urban Africa Photography competition

Partnership between Stephen Lawrence Charitable Trust and Design Museum

Inspired by David Adjaye's photography of Urban Africa, the Design Museum is running a photography competition for under 25s in partnership with the Stephen Lawrence Charitable Trust:

### How to take part:

1. Use your camera phone, digital camera or whatever you have to hand to take a photo. Try to capture something special about the buildings in your city.
2. Give your photo a title or caption.

### Who can take part?

You must be aged 25 or under to take part in the competition. One photo per entry. By entering the competition you consent to your photography being shared online via Flickr and the websites of the Design Museum and the Stephen Lawrence Charitable Trust.

### Judges and prizes

The top 20 photographs will be selected by the Stephen Lawrence Charitable Trust with support from Adjaye Associates and the Design Museum. They will form a special display at the Design Museum and at the Stephen Lawrence Centre. There will also be an online display of photographs on the image-sharing website Flickr.

The top 10 photographers will be invited to a private view of their work at the Design Museum they will also win goody bags and a special photography workshop at the Stephen Lawrence Centre.
